

WINDOW PAGES

Peek-a-Boo Window Album by Sandi Genovese

Cut out progressively smaller windows from the cover and first three pages in a mini book for a sneak peek into the variety of color inside. If page protectors are not available in the custom size of the album you create, simply place vellum sheets in between each of the pages. Die-cut or punch a window out of any of the vellum overlays to focus attention on any part of the photo behind.

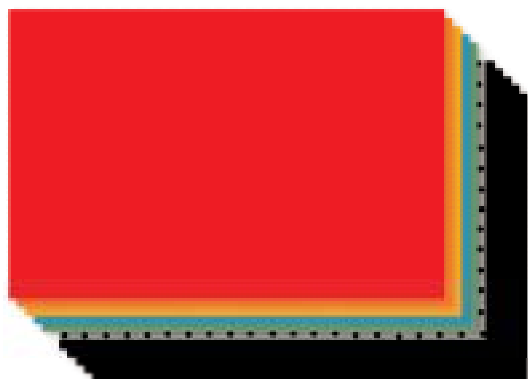

1. Cut colored paper and vellum into 5" x 7-1/2" pages. The number of pages you create is dictated by how thick you want the book to be (Figure A).
2. Mark the mid point (in pencil) along the left end of each page. Use the pencil mark as a guide to cut the notches with the Rollabind cutter (Figure B).

3. Layer the top four pages together in the order you desire.
4. Die-cut a small rectangle out of white scratch paper and tape it onto the first page with removable tape. Use this as a guide to position the die correctly over the first sheet and cut in the die-cutting machine (Figure C).

5. Repeat this process with the small diamond die on the second page, positioning the diamond to nest inside the rectangle (Figure D).
6. Use the large square PaddlePunch to cut out a square in the middle of the third page so that it nests inside the previous cuts (Figure E).

7. Repeat with the small square PaddlePunch, angled like a diamond, in the middle of the fourth page so that it nests inside the previous cuts (Figure F).

8. Place a tiny heart sticker on the fifth page so that it shows through the smallest square window (Figure G).

9. Add a vellum slip sheet in between each of the inside pages.

10. Decorate the first black interior page with themed die-cuts and a title handwritten in silver (Figure H).

a. Drape the embellished sun and palm tree die-cuts over the page edge and trim excess with scissors for a less “posed” look.

11. Die-cut a heart from the vellum slip sheet that sits over the group photo, so that the bride and groom are seen within the heart and the rest of the group is muted by the vellum. The entire photo is visible when the vellum page is turned (Figure I).

12. Attach three black discs to bind the mini book (Figure J).

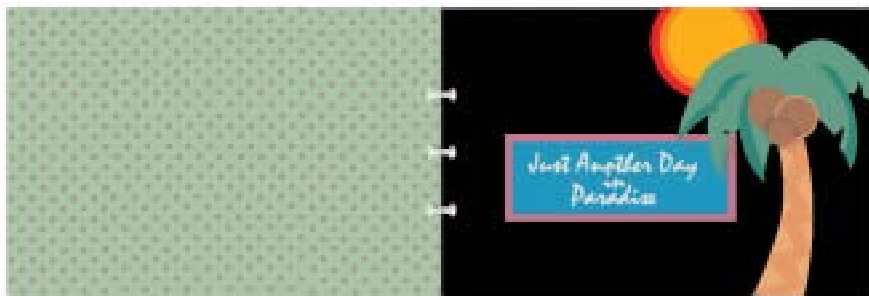
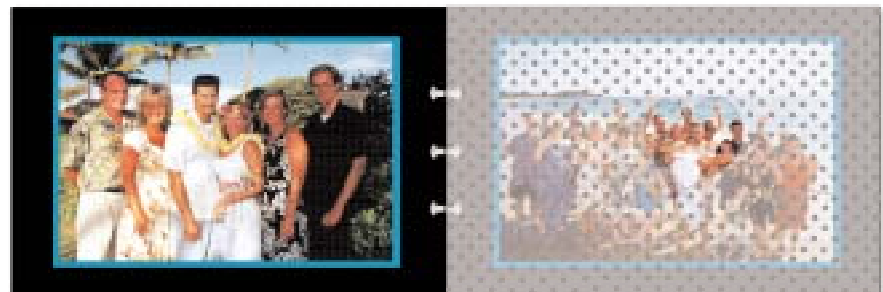
