

STILLS & LANDSCAPES

Make color copies of your favorite landscape photos so that you can cut them up to create unique titles for your pages. Die-cut the photo into letters that are matted and suspended from eyelets for a photo title. The same photo is also used as a mat for journaling.

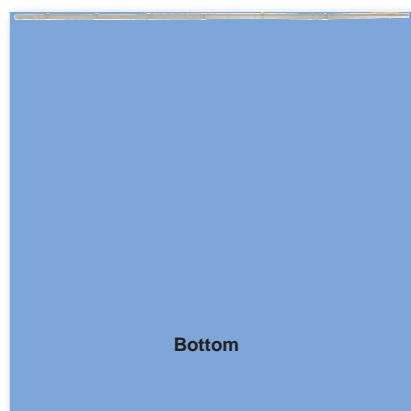

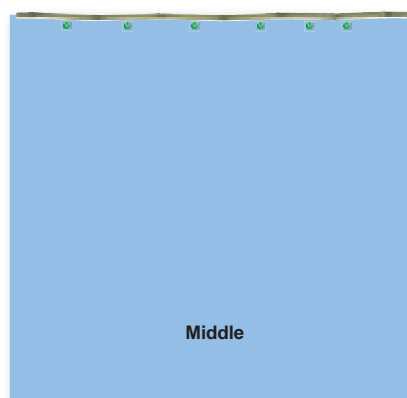

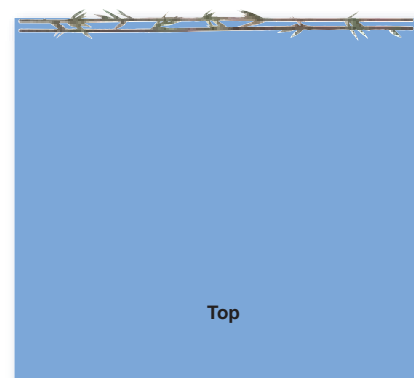

1. Start with three different shades of blue 12" x 12" paper. Create a graduated page by keeping the width 12" and varying the length 1/2" for each color (Figure A, B & C).
2. Attach design line stickers to the top of each paper. Attach six eyelets, one for every letter to the middle sheet (Figure A, B & C).
3. Attach the top and middle pages together using double sided tape (Figure D).

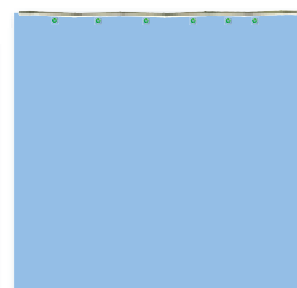
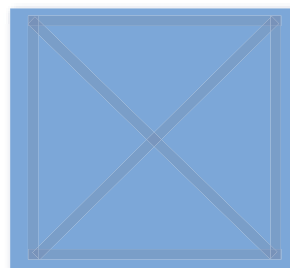

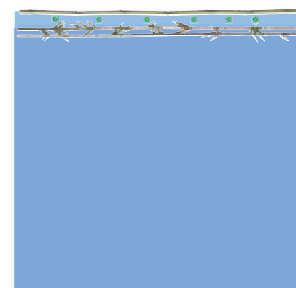

4. Die-cut a landscape photograph and tan paper using the Shadow Box Alphabet. Mat the photograph letters onto the tan shadow (Figure E).

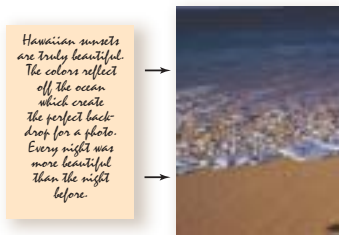

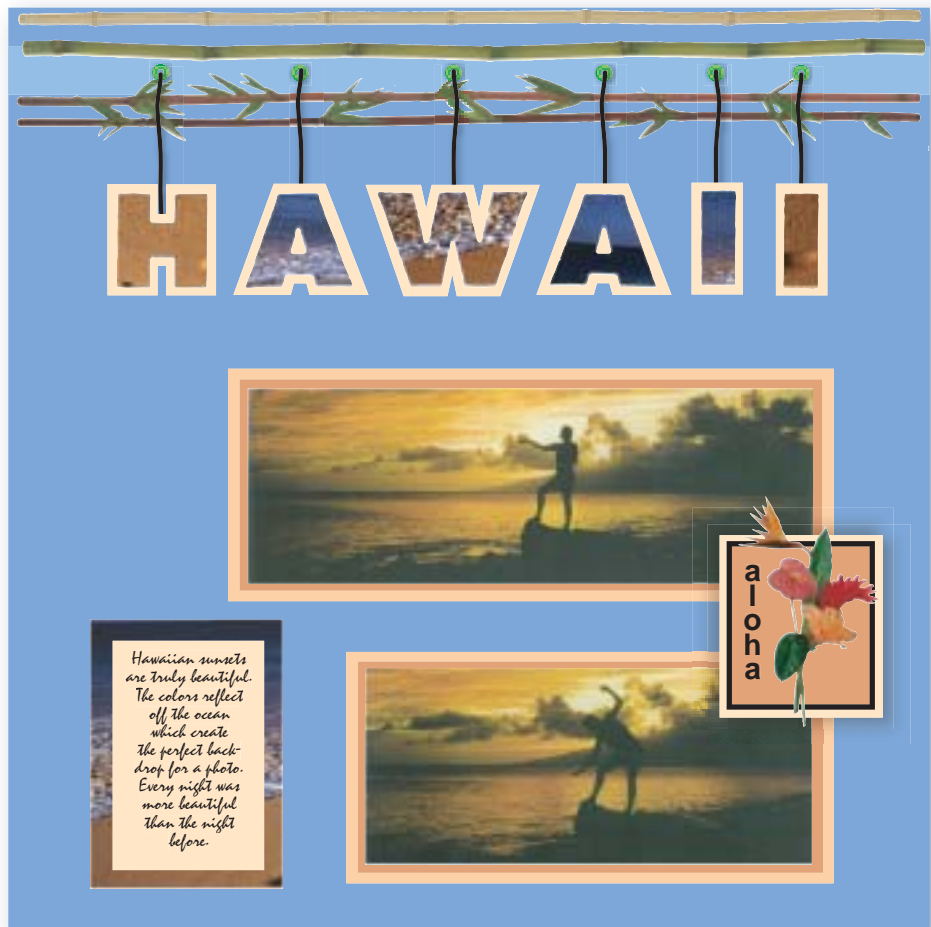

5. Thread a small amount of black embroidery thread through each eyelet and attach the excess to the back of the page using tape. On the front of the scrapbook page attach one letter over each hanging group of thread (Figure F).
6. Attach the combined middle and top paper to the bottom using double stick tape (Figure F).
7. Double mat photographs using two shades of tan paper and arrange on the page (Figure F).
8. Using the same landscape photograph mat a journaling panel and attach it to the page (Figure E).
9. Triple mat a square and add a sticker bouquet and stickerletters. Attach it to the page using foam dots to create dimension (Figure F).
