



"LET IT SNOW" ...

Gift Bag & Tag



BASIC INGREDIENTS...



Materials needed:

- Wimpole Street Creations mini natural knit hat
- Wimpole Street Creations medium natural knit bag
- Two Wimpole Street Creations small natural knit mittens
- Six Wimpole Street Creations assorted square buttons
- Four Wimpole Street Creations mini buttons
- Four mini clothespins
- 1-1/2 yards of natural embroidery floss
- 24" of jute
- 7" x 10" piece of natural cardstock
- 6" x 10" piece of patterned navy paper
- 6" x 12" piece of sand cardstock
- 2" x 3" piece of vellum
- Coordinating gift bag and tissue
- Double-stick tape, Xyron machine or other adhesive
- Chenille needle

Note: adapt these ideas for a winter scrapbook page.

1. Cut one 7" x 8" piece and one 1" square from the natural cardstock for the bag, and two 1-1/2" square pieces for the tag. Cut one 5-3/4" x 7-3/4" piece and two 1" squares from the navy paper for the bag, and two 1-1/2" squares for the tag. Cut one 5-1/2" x 7-1/2" piece and one 1" square from the sand cardstock for the bag, and one 4" square for the tag.
2. Layer the 5-3/4" x 7-3/4" navy paper and the 5-1/2" x 7-1/2" sand cardstock on the side of the large natural cardstock piece. Attach the four 1" squares to the right side of the large card as shown. Center the four 1-1/2" squares on the 4" square tag.
3. Roll the cuff of the knit bag once to make a cap. Run the knit pieces through the Xyron machine with repositionable adhesive.
4. Tie a knot on each end of the jute and position it on the card as desired. Place the knit pieces over the jute and stick in place. Clip the knit cap and mittens to the "clothesline" with the clothespins.
5. Stitch the square buttons on the right side of the card, using six strands of floss.
6. Hand-print "Let it Snow" on the vellum. Tear a narrow strip from each long side of the vellum, or cut with decorative scissors. Place the vellum on the lower half of the tag. Stitch the mini buttons to each corner of the tag. Punch a hole in the top of the tag for the floss.
7. Attach the card to the gift bag with double-stick tape. Tie the gift tag to the bag with floss.
8. Add coordinating tissue with the points poking up out of the bag.
