

# Step-by-Step QUILLING

*Quilling is the art of creating beautiful scrolled shapes from strips of paper. Design a scrapbook layout that incorporates the strip characteristics of quilling. Then add whimsically coiled Quillettes™ accent pieces to your scrapbook page for an elaborate look.*



## SUPPLIES

- Jolee's By You™ Quillettes™
  - Floral Heart
- Tweezer Bee™ Tweezers
- Kaliedopunch™ — Citrine Snowflake
- Cutterpede™ Straight Edge Trimmer
- Cutter Bee™ Scissors
- Hobby awl
- White glue
- Card stock— green, light green, pink, pale pink, white
- Ink jet transparency

## TECHNIQUE TIPS

1. Print journaling on a clear transparency so that the stripes of the design are not covered.
2. Quilled accents can carry a lot of visual weight; add weight to your title by using bold lettering elements.
3. Quilled pieces can be very small; keep the scale of your design consistent, and make your photos small.

## STEPS

- STEP 1:** Select a pre-made series of quilled objects or one item that has many quilled pieces. In this example the Quillettes™ Floral Heart was used.
- STEP 2:** Begin by taking apart the heart. Remove all flowers, and place them to the side. Cut 1/8" strips of cardstock, and quill them into vines on which the flowers will grow.
- STEP 3:** Arrange the quilled strips on a 2" border of the foundation page to create vines. Decorate the quilled vines with the pre-quilled flowers.
- STEP 4:** Complete the final touches. Continue using the strip concept of quilling, and place strips of paper in the background. Mat the photos, and print out a title and journaling on a transparency.
