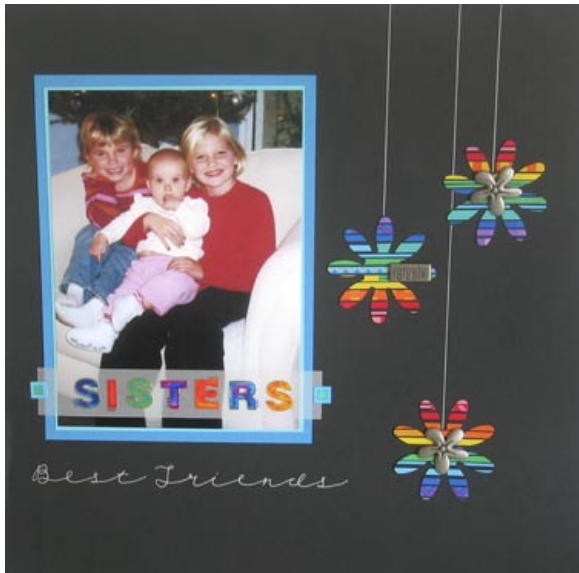


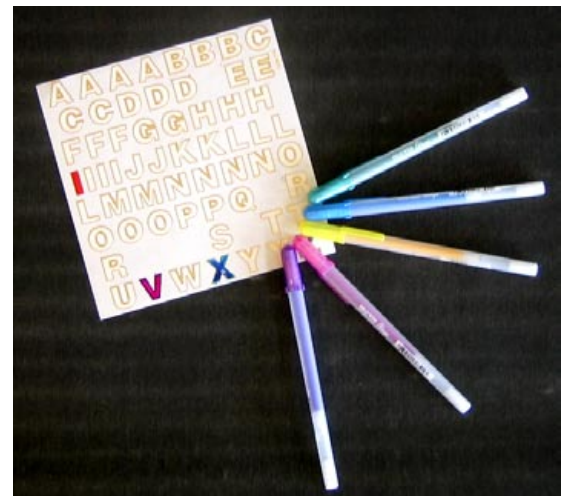
# STICKERS TO THE EXTREME

Transform ordinary sticker strips into three dimensional paper that can then be die-cut or punched into wonderfully textured page enhancements. Create the look of metallic foil lettering with the aid of glaze pens and a white sticker alphabet.



1. Layer sticker strips in a random pattern onto black paper, leaving some of the black to show through. Some areas can consist of two or three layers of stickers depending on the look you want.
2. Die-cut or punch flowers from the stickered paper.
3. Attach the flowers to the background page overlapping each flower with a metal enhancement. Draw a silver line with a metallic pen and ruler from each flower to the top of the page so that the flowers appear to be hanging.
4. Double mat the photo and attach it to the page.
5. Color over white sticker letters with glaze pens. The ink stays wet long enough to mix and blend the colors. Let the inks dry completely before removing the colored letters to attach to a vellum strip.
6. Fasten the decorated vellum strip over the photo with sticker squares.
7. Add journaling with a silver metallic pen. To transfer a computer font to dark paper, rub a pencil over the back side of the copy paper directly behind the lettering. Turn the copy paper over, place it on top of the black page and trace over the letters with a sharp pencil or pen. This will transfer the letters to the black page where you can trace over them with a silver pen to complete the page.

- Ruler
- Paper: Canson
- Flower Punch: Family Treasures
- Silver pen: Sakura
