

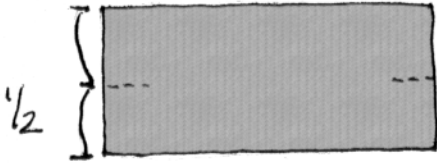
Folded t-shirt earrings by Karen Thomas

Fold two to make earrings.

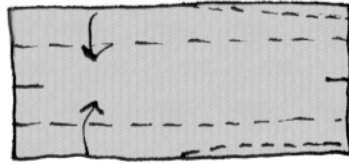
Earring paper size: 1 1/2" x 3"

Start with pattern side up

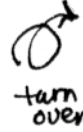
Cupboard both sides to center, unfold.



To find center of strip, pinch at half way point on each end.



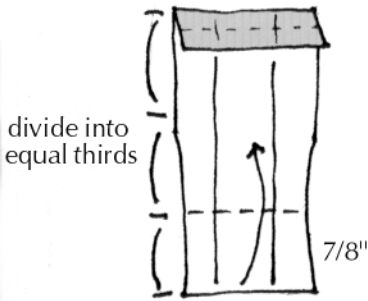
Fold 1/8" creases at an angle at one end of the strip.



Fold a 3/8" hem on the wider end of the strip.

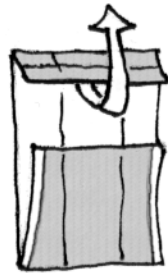


Fold the 3/8" hem in half up to the folded edge.

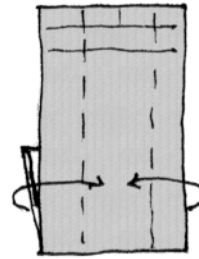
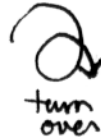


divide into equal thirds

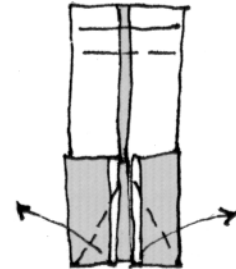
Fold the bottom edge up at 1/3"



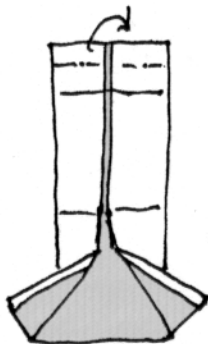
Unfold top hem and turn over.



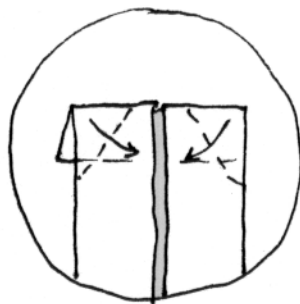
Cupboard fold both layers to the center



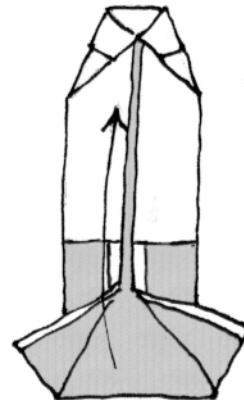
Fold top layers at an angle to create sleeves.



Fold the top edge to the back.



Fold the top corners down at an angle to the center.



Fold bottom up to tuck under collar edge.



Varnish both shirts and let dry.
Punch tiny holes at the top.
Add beads and earring wires.
