

PET PAGES

Our pets are such an important part of our lives it only makes sense that we would want to include them in our scrapbooks. Put your computer to good use in the creation of pages that include scanned copies of their favorite toys.

1. Collect your pet's favorite toys and scan them into the computer (fig.1). Outline and arrange them in Photoshop (or another photo editing program) and print on vellum to create a toy border. (fig.2)
2. Layer swatches of colored and printed paper onto a red background page. Title the page with vellum stickers that spell the pet's name. Cut out one toy from the scanned images and attach it under the name. (fig.2)

3. Arrange photos and fasten to the page (leave the bottom portion of the middle photo un-stuck to allow placement of vellum underneath).
4. Add additional photos and journaling in a see through mini book and cover it with another photo before attaching it to the page. (fig.4)
5. Position the vellum strip (of toys) about an inch from the bottom of the page. Secure it with brads in the top corners. (This strip will overlap one photo).
6. Fasten a vellum grass border to the bottom of the page which also overlaps the vellum toy strip to complete the page. (fig.3)

- Vellum paper: Paper Adventures
- See through mini book: Provo Craft
- Plain paper: Canson
- Eyelets: Making Memories
- Printer: Epson
- Patterned paper: Paper Patch
- Computer: Apple (Mac)
