

HARVEST

Celebrate the fall season with a scrapbook that opens to display your photos in a three dimensional format. Decorate the cover with layered linen stickers. Add photos, embellishments and journaling to the inside pages. Open the book and pull the front cover around to the back and secure it with a decorative clip to hold the book open to reveal the three dimensional format with photos and journaling inside.



1. Select four sheets of 12" x 12" paper. Fold one in half, open and fold in half the other way.
2. Cut along one fold line into the middle and trim away half of the square (to make a triangle). Fold the triangle in half. Save the loose triangle (unfolded) for the inside cover pocket.
3. Trim one fourth of the square away leaving a flap for gluing. Fold the square closed, fastening the flap to the folded triangle.
4. Repeat to create three more sections in the book.
5. Fasten the folded squares together, fronts to backs. Fasten a triangle pocket to the inside front and back cover, capturing a ribbon tie between the layers. Edge the pockets with sticker strips.





6. Decorate the front cover with a layered linen sticker on a matted square. Raise some of the elements with foam tape to add dimension. Finish the cover with colored brads and a rub on word.

7. Cut a journaling strip to fit inside the pocket and attach a loop of ribbon with stickers to make it easy to pull out the journaling paper.

8. Add matted photos, journaling and embellishments to the inside pages to complete the book.
