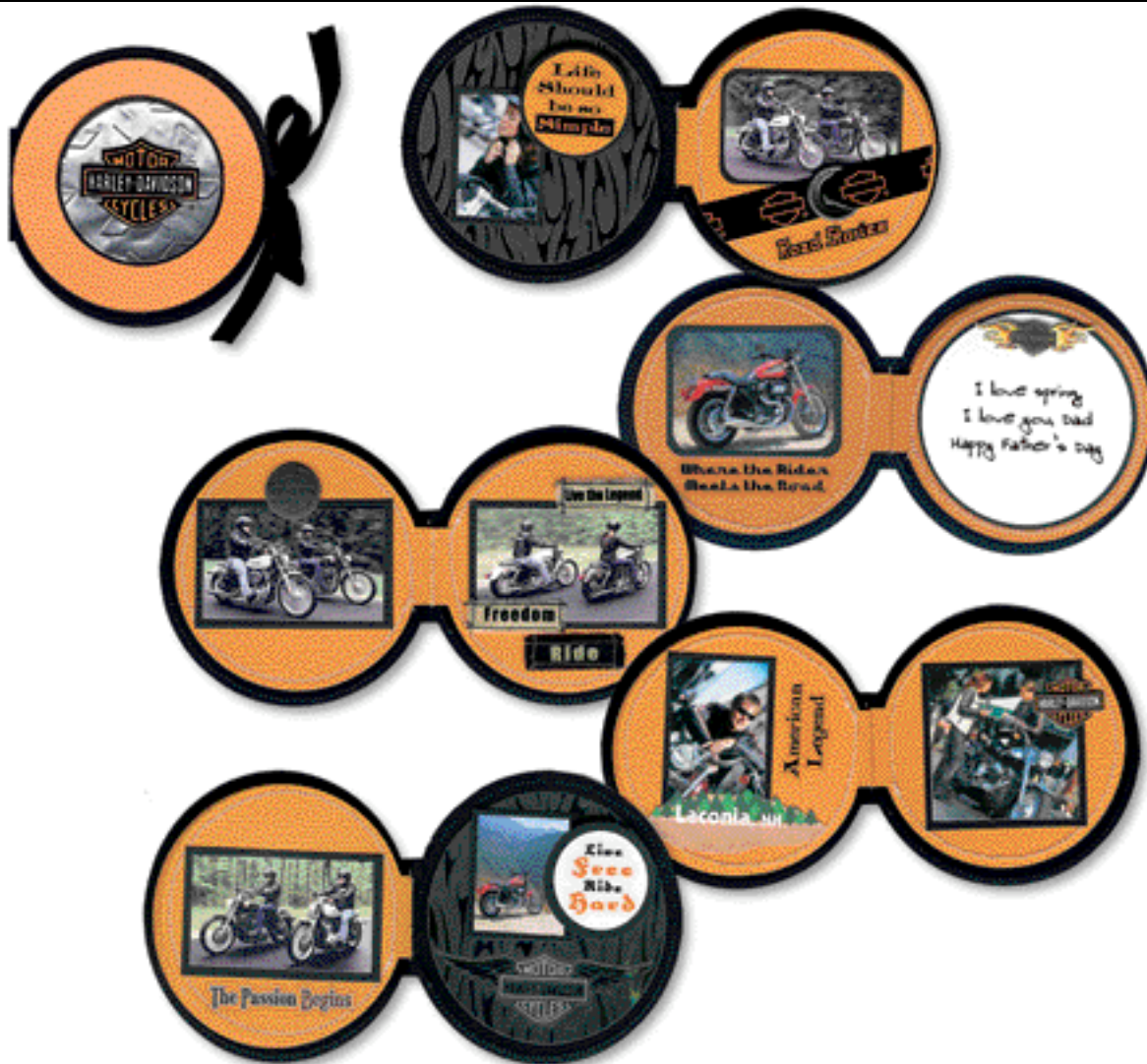


HARLEY-DAVIDSON®

MINI SCRAPBOOK

Capture your traveling memories in a handmade Harley-Davidson® Mini Scrapbook. This is an ideal sized scrapbook to slip in a pocket, bag or back pack to share cherished memories with friends and family.

SUPPLIES

- Phrase Café™
- Circle Scissor®
- Glass Mat
- Repositionable Tape
- Orange and Black Cardstock
- Harley-Davidson® papers and embellishments by EK Success
- Sewing Machine
- HERMA® Adhesive

STEPS:

- 1** Select a size for your travel album. Find a comparable measurement size on the Circle Scissor®. In this case I used a measurement of 3 3/4" in diameter the comparable measurement on the Circle Scissor® is #82. Please see the templates if you do not have a Circle Scissor®. Mat the photos with double matts.
- 2** Create the pages of the mini-book. Score a piece of 12 x 12" paper along a 4" line. Fold along the score line. From the top of the paper and 1/8" in from the folded edge, measure and mark at 2", 2 1/2", and 3" increments along the fold of the paper.
- 3** Create a guide for the Circle Scissor®. Cut a 2 x 1/4" strip from scrap paper. Adhere the strip of paper 1/8" above the #82 cutting hole. This strip will serve as a guide to line up the Circle Scissor® when cutting the mini-book pages.
- 4** Secure the folded and measured cardstock to a glass surface using repositionable tape. Place the #82 circle on the Circle Scissor® approximately 1/8" in from the folded edge and in line with the 2 1/2" mark. (Line up the guide on your Circle Scissor® with the folded edge) Using the 2" and 3" marks as a guide, begin cutting the circle at the 2" mark and end the circle at the 3" mark cutting through two thicknesses of paper. (If the cardstock is too thick for the pen blade to cut through both thicknesses, do not panic, simply use a craft knife to complete the cut through the second layer). Cut the circle from the folded edge. Create four pages for the mini-book.

STEPS:

- 5 Line the pages up back to back covering any markings, adhere together. Sew around the circles of each page. Because this book is handmade, things may not line up exactly right – that is OK. Use a craft knife or scissors to correct any glaring line-up problems.
- 6 Stack the sewn pages on top of one another and sew down the center of the pages.
- 7 Create a cover page in a contrasting color. Cut two cover pages following the guidelines in steps 2 and 3. This time instead of placing the Circle Scissor® measurement inside the folded edge, place the measurement right on the folded edge. In this example, a size #92
- 8 Cut 2 cover pages and sew them together as in Step 3.
- 9 Stack the inside pages on the cover and sew down the center to create the book.
- 10 Design the mini-book with Harley-Davidson® papers, embellishments and stickers from EK Success.

circle on the Circle Scissor® was used. The measurements for the spine are a total of $1\frac{3}{4}$ ". The first mark is made $1\frac{1}{2}$ " from the top of the paper with marks at $2\frac{1}{4}$ " and 3". Center the 92" hole at the $2\frac{1}{4}$ " mark then begin cutting at $1\frac{1}{2}$ " and end cutting at 3".
