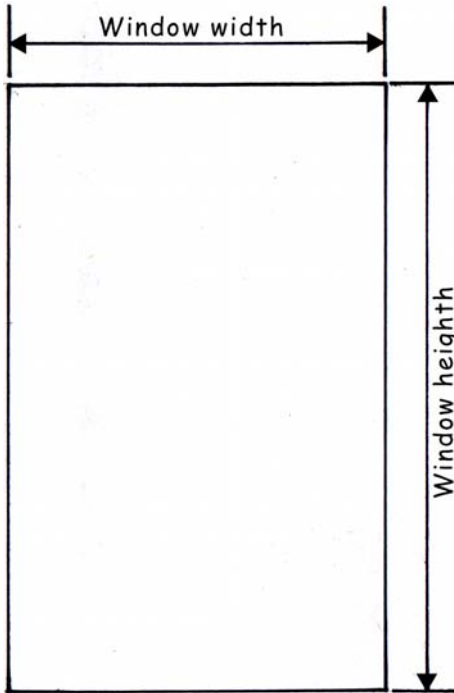


## FOLDED CURTAIN TEMPLATE

Before starting your template, please note that the folded curtain will only work on rectangular windows that are higher than they are wide.

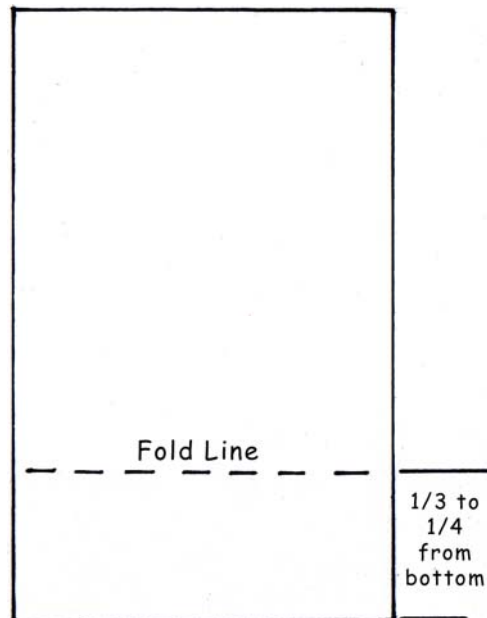


### STEP ONE

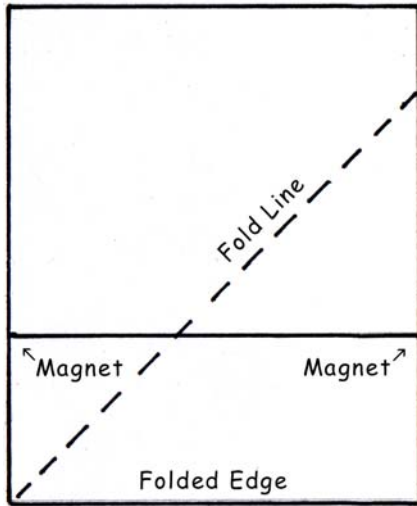
Cut craft paper the same size as the inside edge of the window frame. (Reminder: This template is cut to the finished size of your curtain. Later, when you mark your fabric using this paper template, you will add a 1" seam allowance all around.)

### STEP TWO

Fold the paper up approximately 1/4 to 1/3 up from the bottom. The amount you fold will determine how high your curtain will be when open. Try different amounts to see what works best for your window.



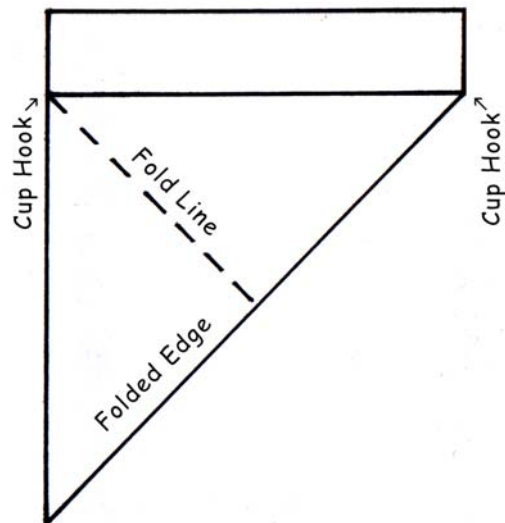
## FOLDED CURTAIN TEMPLATE, page 2



### STEP THREE

With the paper folded up from the bottom locate and mark the position of the magnets that will hold the curtain up. Then fold the bottom right corner diagonally to meet the left edge.

Once the paper is folded diagonally, the location of the cup hooks that will hold the fold can be determined and marked on the window frame. The cup hooks will be screwed into the frame. Next fold the bottom left corner diagonally to meet the right edge.

Now that the paper is completely folded, note the location of the metal hoops that will be sewn into the curtain to connect with the cup hooks. Your template is complete! You're ready to cut your fabric. But don't forget to add those 1" seam allowances!
