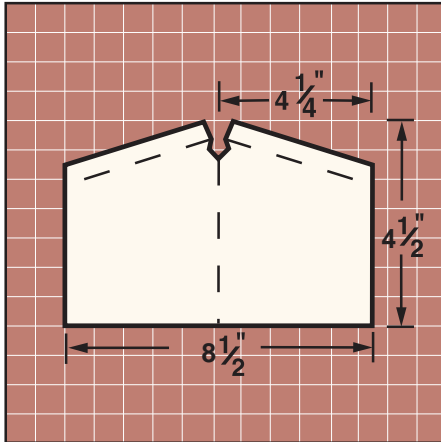
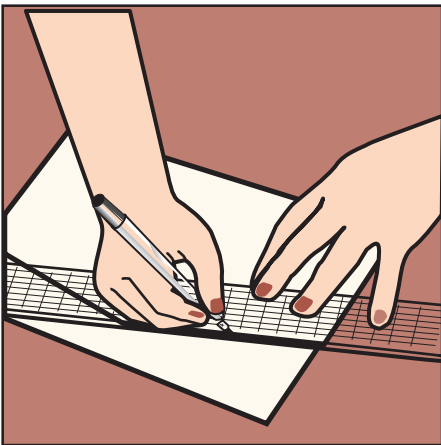


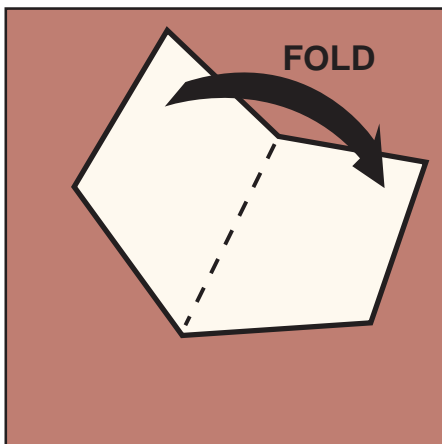
Pop-Up Page



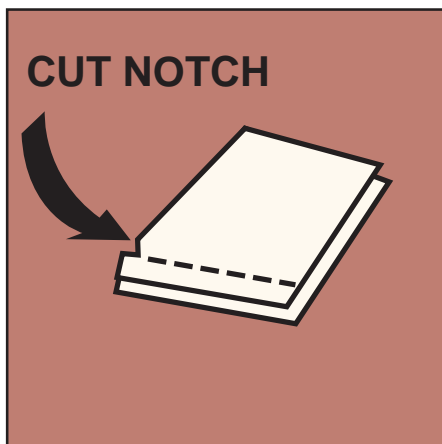
1. The finished pop-up mechanism will measure 8-1/2 inches across the bottom, 4-1/2 inches down the center, and 4-1/4 inches on each remaining side. Use a ruler and pencil to make measured marks for cutting the pop-up mechanism on a sheet of card stock.



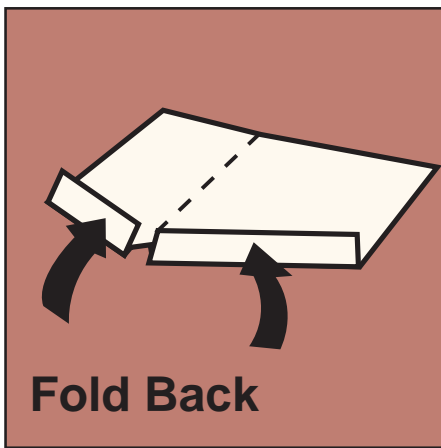
2. Use a straightedge and craft knife to cut out the perimeter of the pop-up mechanism in a simple house shape. If desired, modify the template to fit smaller scrapbook pages by trimming the outer edges and corners of this cutout.



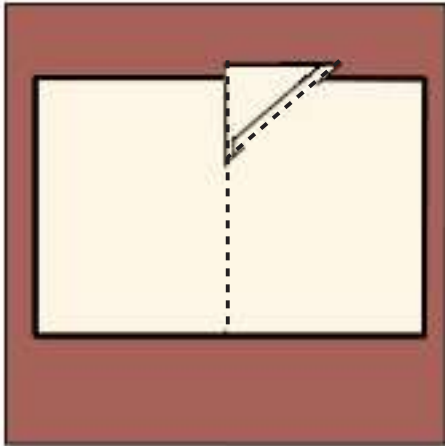
3. Fold the pop-up mechanism in half.



4. Cut a notch at the center top of the folded mechanism.

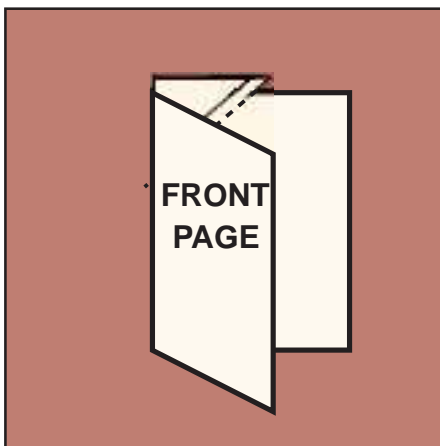


5. Unfold the mechanism and place it on a work surface with the center fold “mountain” side up. Use an embossing stylus or a straightedge to score fold lines on either side of the notch, along the top diagonal edges of the mechanism to fashion mounting flaps. Score well and “valley” fold the flaps back.

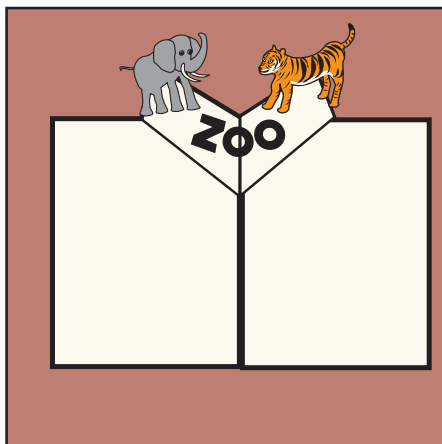


6. Holding the mounting flaps in folded position, fold the mechanism in half at the center mountain fold.

Fold a second sheet of card stock in half to form a card. Mount the right-hand back side of the card to a scrapbook page. Open the card and line up the fold of the card with the center fold in the mechanism--top edges flush. With the pop-up mechanism folded, apply adhesive to the right-hand mounting flap and adhere it to the right side of the folded card stock.



7. Keeping the pop-up folded, apply adhesive to the left-hand side of the mounting flap. Fold the left-hand side of the card over and adhere it to the back of the pop-up.



8. Open the layout, forcing the center fold out. Embellish the pop-up with picture cutouts, stickers, etc. If desired, reinforce the mechanism by applying a border sticker or mounting paper.
