

Victorian Row House Page



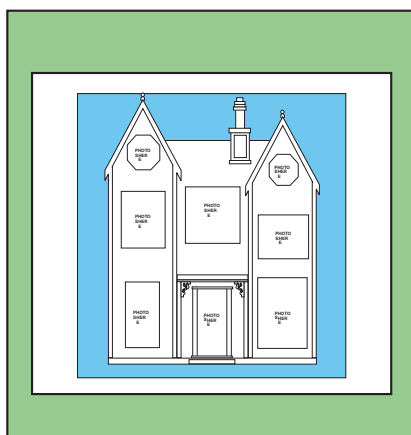
1. Print the Finished House pattern onto acid-free card stock or paper.



2. If printing on paper, mount the image onto card stock. If printing on card stock, proceed to step 3.



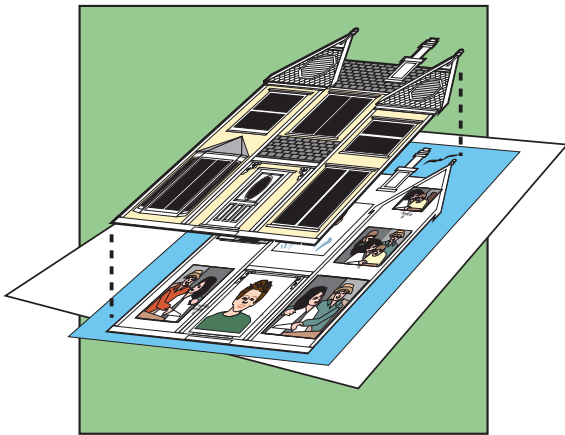
3. Use a craft knife to cut out around windows and door of the house, leaving one side attached in each opening to act as a hinge.



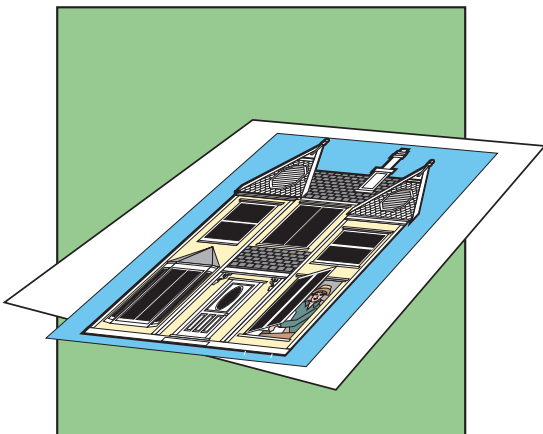
4. Print the Frame House pattern indicating where to mount photographs onto acid-free paper. Cut out around the perimeter and adhere the pattern to colored card stock or directly to the scrapbook page.



5. Adhere photographs to the House Frame pattern as indicated.



6. Adhere the Finished House cutout to the House Frame cutout. Take care not to glue the windows or doors shut. Double-sided tape works best for this step.



7. Open the doors and windows of the Finished House cutout to reveal the photographs. Embellish the house with stickers or paper cutouts to suit any occasion including Halloween, Christmas and more.
