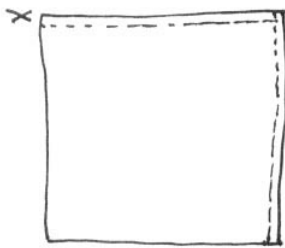
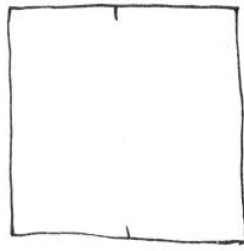


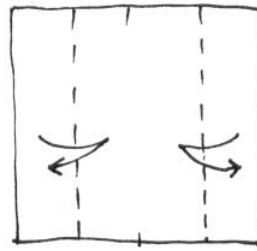
Cut 1/8" off two sides of the paper



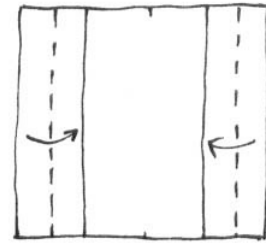
Pattern or color side down



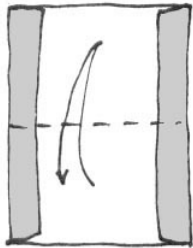
Pinch fold 1/4" on opposite sides to find center



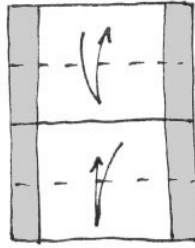
Fold to center then unfold like cupboard doors



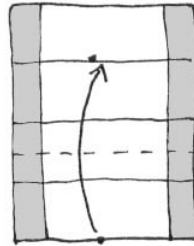
Fold to the first creases.



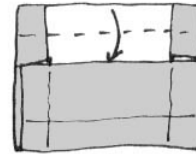
Fold the top half down then unfold.



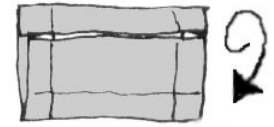
Cupboard fold to center then unfold.



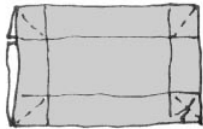
Fold bottom edge to uppermost crease.



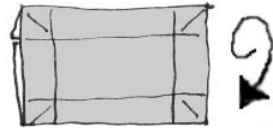
Fold top edge down to meet raw edge.



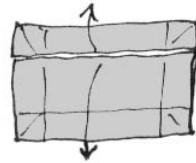
Turn the model over.



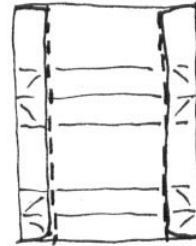
Make creases at all four corners inside the little squares from the center crease line to the outer edge.



Turn the model over.



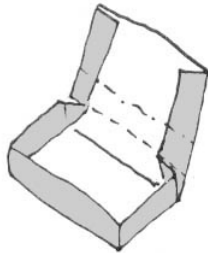
Open top and bottom layers.
