

Garden Vintage Sweatshirt Jacket



Materials needed:

- Two sets each of *Wimpole Street Creations* daffodil/dragonfly and iris/butterfly vintage appliques*
- Moss green floss (DMC 469)*
- Chenille needle*
- Fleece sweatshirt
- Black thread

1. Carefully trim the knit ribbing from the bottom of the sweatshirt and sleeves.
2. Cut down the center front of the sweatshirt to make a jacket.
3. Turn up the inside fleece edges and press 2" on the sleeves and 1" on the bottom edge of the shirt. Fold out 1" on both front edges and press. The inside of the sweatshirt will be hemmed on the outside of the jacket. Mitre the corners of the neck ribbing and fold outward in half. Pin in place.
4. Position applique pieces as desired and iron in place. Machine-stitch around the edges of the applique pieces for permanent placement.
5. Hand-embroider a decorative X-stitch around the folded bottom, sleeve edges, jacket fronts and neck of the sweatshirt.
