



Metal Ribbon Angel

Materials

3/4 yard of metal ribbon
18 or 20 mm wooden or plastic bead for head
gold or silver metallic pipe cleaner
permanent marker or paints for face (optional)

Steps:

1. Fold the ribbon like you would a paper fan. The panels can be any width, but 1/2 inch works best.
2. Once you have folded it 10 times, carefully cut it.
3. Run the pipe cleaner through the top of the fan. Make a little loop and twist, leaving at least a 10-inch tail.
4. Begin folding the extra ribbon again. This time fold 5 to 7 times, depending on the fullness you want. When you have completed this step, run the pipe cleaner through the middle and align the wings to the body.
5. Run the remaining pipe cleaner through the bead (head) and push down in place.
6. With the excess, make a halo.
7. You can draw or paint a face, but the blank bead works well, too. Clear beads also look nice with the metallic ribbon.
