



Sock Monkey Angel Ornament/Finger Puppet

Materials:

Susan's Delusions rubber stamps: bear angel, sock monkey
embossing ink stamp pad
embossing powder
embossing heat tool
red or other marker(s) or colored pencils
scissors
card stock
glue

Steps:

1. Stamp and emboss the bear angel and sock monkey on ivory cardstock. Tip: Stamp and emboss or color the back of the wings as well; they show when the angel is assembled.
2. Color the images as desired.
3. Cut out the bear angel's wings and skirt as one piece, removing the bear completely.
4. Cut between the wing tips and cut the 2 marked slits.
5. Cut out the sock monkey's upper body. Remove the tail and lower legs.
6. Slide the sock monkey into the skirt (where the bear was) and glue in place.
7. Loop and interlock the slits on the skirt to make a freestanding angel ornament. Or, leave flat for mailing!

Below is how the stamped, glued piece will look before interlocking for assembly.
