



Kwanzaa Angels
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Materials

flat head clothespins
doll hair
ethnic-print material
pinking shears
brown paint
black and red permanent markers
glue
brown pipe cleaners/chenille stems
sparkly pipe cleaners/chenille stems

Steps:

1. Paint clothespins brown. Let dry.
2. Cut two rectangular pieces of ethnic material using pinking shears.
3. Wrap a brown pipe cleaner around the clothespin, forming arms.
4. Fold one piece of material in half and cut a 1/4-inch neck opening. Glue pieces of material wrong sides together on clothespin at the shoulder and the sides, bringing the arms through.
5. Glue a small amount of doll hair to the top and side of clothespin, forming a hairstyle.
6. With the black marker, draw on eyes and nose. Draw mouth with red marker. Give each angel a unique face.
7. Using the sparkly pipe cleaner, form a halo by twisting one end into a small circle, leaving a stem approximately 1 inch long, and attach to the back of clothespin. This will also make a place to put an ornament hanger.
