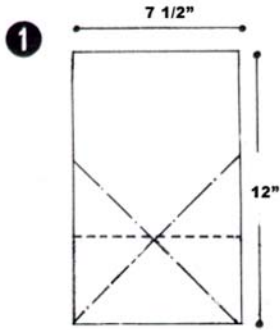
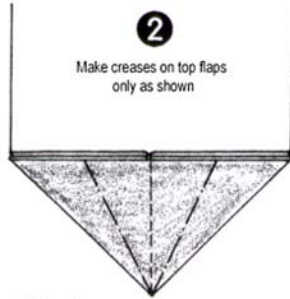


Crane Card



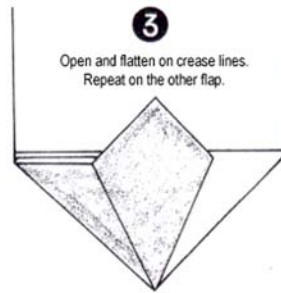
Mountain fold diagonally as shown. Valley fold at the intersection as shown.

Push sides in and collapse so that you have a triangle with two flaps.



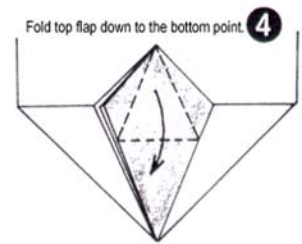

Make creases on top flaps only as shown



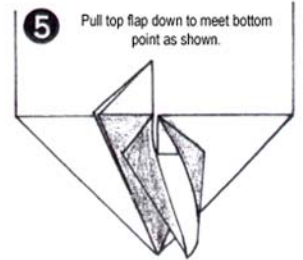

Open and flatten on crease lines. Repeat on the other flap.



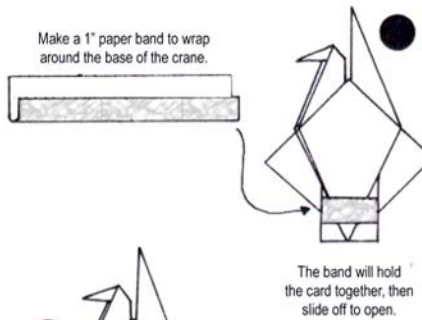

Fold top flap down to the bottom point.



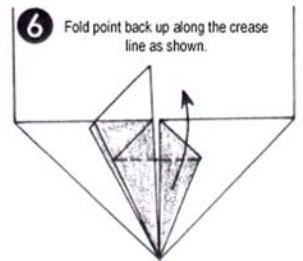

Pull top flap down to meet bottom point as shown.



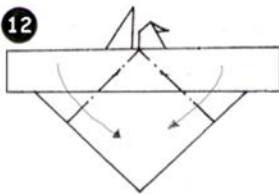
Make a 1" paper band to wrap around the base of the crane.

The band will hold the card together, then slide off to open.



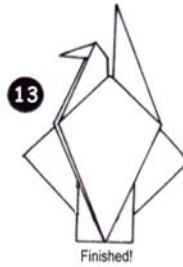

Fold point back up along the crease line as shown.



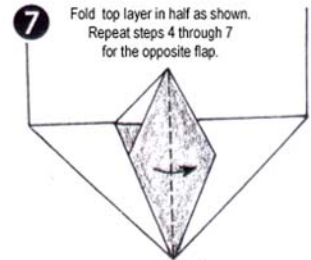

Turn the model over. The top edge will meet in the center. Crease well.

Finished!



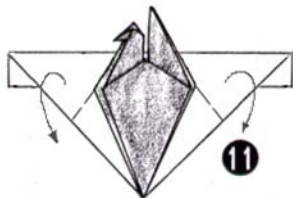

Turn the model over

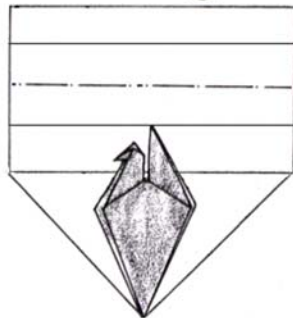
Make accordion folds at top edge.

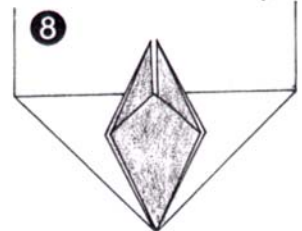
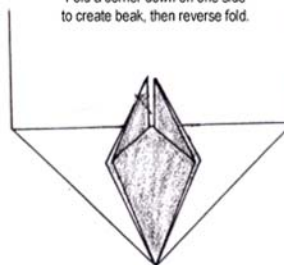
