## Stars Surrounded from *Burgoyne Surrounded*



Quilt size- 74" x 74"

Block Size- 17";

Fabric Requirements:

White background – 4 1/2 yds.: Red for blocks sashing and borders – 4 1/2 yds.: Blue for blocks – 1yd.: Tan for blocks –1/2 yd.: Gold for blocks and sashing 1/4 yd: Assorted reds for block center units – 6" square for each block (9): Assorted blues for block center units – 6" square for each block (9): Assorted light neutrals for block center units – 8" square for each block (9): Assorted golds for block center units – 8" square for each block (9): Backing –4 5/8 yds. : Batting-80" x 80"

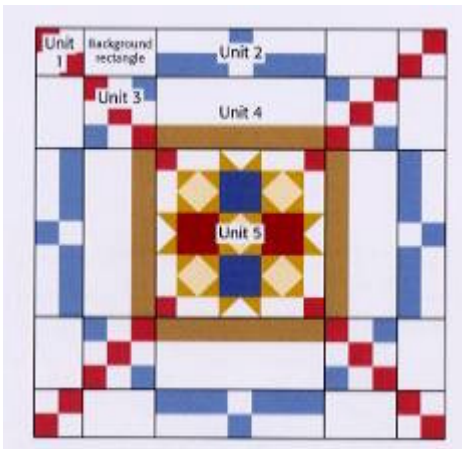
Cut white strips: 1 1/4" wide-4; 1 3/8" wide-7; 1 1/2"wide-49; 2 1/2" wide-15; 3 1/2" wide-6

Cut red strips: 1 3/8" wide-2; 1 1/2" wide-20; 2" wide-1

Cut blue strips: 1 1/2" wide-6; 3 1/2" wide-6

Cut tan strips: 1 1/2" wide-8:

Cut gold strips: 1 1/4" wide-3



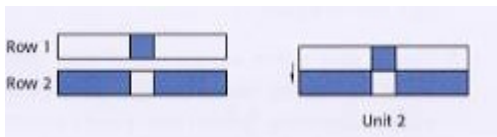
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Make the units as shown above. To complete the quilt you will need 36 of Units 1 through 4 and 9 of Unit 5.

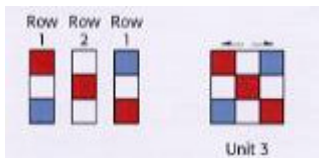
Make Unit 1: Make 3 stripsets using one red strip and one white strip each, 1 1/2" wide. Crosscut strip sets into 72 segments and sew together to make Unit 1 as shown.



Make Unit 2: Make 3 strip sets each for rows 1 and 2 as shown, using two white or blue 3 1/2" wide strips and one white or blue 1 1/2" wide strip per set. Press seams toward white. Crosscut strip sets into 1 1/2" segments. Cut one segment from both row 1 and row 2 strips sets for each unit 2 required. Sew together to make unit 2 as shown.



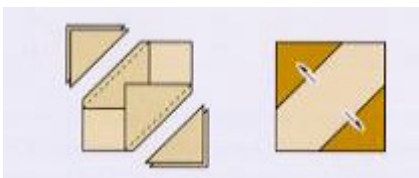
Make Unit 3: Make 3 strip sets for row 1 and 2 strips sets for row 2 as shown, using red, white and blue 1 1/2" wide strips. Press seams away from white. Crosscut strip sets into 1 1/2" segments. Sew two row 1 segments and one row 2 segment together as shown to make unit 3.



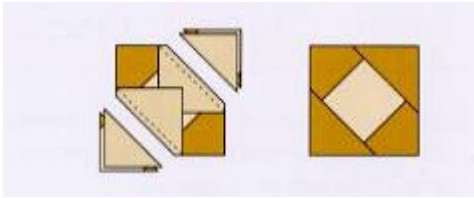
Make Unit 4: Make 8 strip sets using one tan strip 1 1/2" wide and one white 2 1/2" wide strip. Press toward white. Crosscut into 7 1/2" wide segments. Cut one segment for each unit 4 required.

Make Unit 5: Crosscut 36 squares from the red 1 3/8" strips and 108 squares from the white 1 3/8" strips. For each unit five required cut the following pieces from one of the assorted red, blue, light neutral and gold fabrics. Red- 2 squares, 2 1/4"; Blue- 2 squares, 2 1/4"; Light Neutral- 5 squares, 2 1/4"; Gold- 28 squares, 1 3/8". Draw a diagonal line on the back of each gold square.

Place matching gold squares on opposite corners of a light neutral 2 1/4" gold square, right sides together and raw edges even. Using the drawn line as a guide, stitch a needle's width outside each line. The edge of the needle should just touch the line. Trim the seam allowances to 1/8". Press the gold pieces away from the square, forming two new corners for the square. Repeat for the remaining two corners. Repeat with each light neutral square, using the same gold squares for each different light neutral square.



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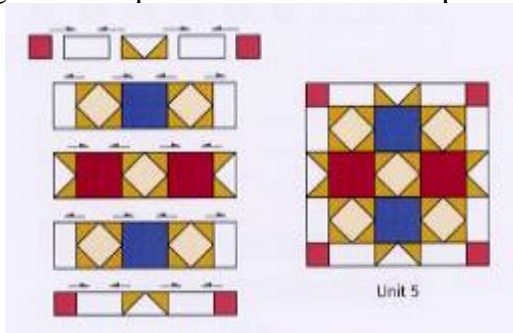


Use the same technique with the remaining gold squares and the 4 white rectangles, 1 3/8" x 2 1/4" to make star point units

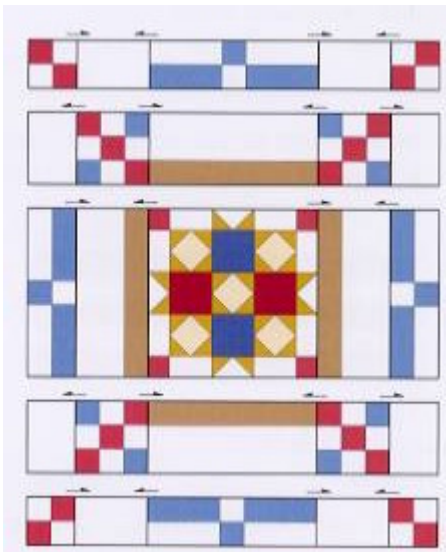


Crosscut the white 2 1/2" strips into 72 rectangles, 2 1/2" x 3 1/2".

Arrange the unit pieces into rows. Stitch pieces into rows and the stitch rows together.

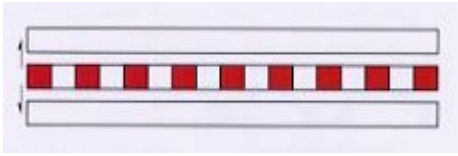


Assemble the blocks: Arrange units as shown. Sew into rows and then sew rows together.



Make the Sashing: Crosscut 48 strips, 1 1/2" x 17 1/2" strips from the 1 1/2" wide white strips. Use leftovers of strips to cut 48 squares, 1 1/2". Make 3 strip sets for the pieced sashing row using three red and two white strips per set. Press toward red strips. Crosscut sets into 72 segments, 1 1/2" wide. Use three segments and two white squares to make 24 pieced sashing rows as shown. Sew a 1 1/2' x 17 1/2" white strip to both sides of each pieced sashing row.

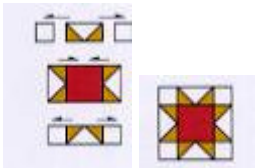
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Make side sashing blocks; Use red and white 1 1/2" strips to make one strip set each of row 1 and row 2 as shown. Crosscut each set into 8 segments. Cut 8 rectangles, 1 1/2" x 3 1/2" from the 1 1/2" white strips. Use segments and rectangles to make 8 side sashing blocks as shown.



Make star sashing blocks: Cut 32 white squares, 1 1/4"; 32 white rectangles, 1 1/4" x 2"; 64 gold squares, 1 1/4" and 8 red squares 2". Refer to directions for star center unit to make 8 star sashing blocks as shown.



Follow the picture to assemble the quilt. Sew the blocks into rows and then sew the rows together. Add 6" wide straight-cut red borders. Quilt as desired. Bind.
